

# Zippered Pillow Case Cover Tutorial

## Supplies Needed:

Cotton Material, Size as Needed or  
Black Out Curtain Material, Size as Needed  
21 inch or longer Invisible Zipper  
Thread  
Rotary Cutter/Scissors  
Ruler/measuring Tape  
Sewing Machine/Serger

### Pillow Case Sizes:

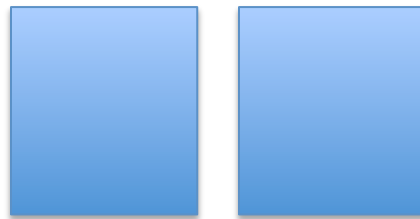
Standard	20 X 26	21 X 25
Super Standard	20 X 28	21 X 27
Queen	20 X 30	21 X 29
King	20 X 36	21 X 35

**Cut 2 of each size/per Pillow**

## Steps:

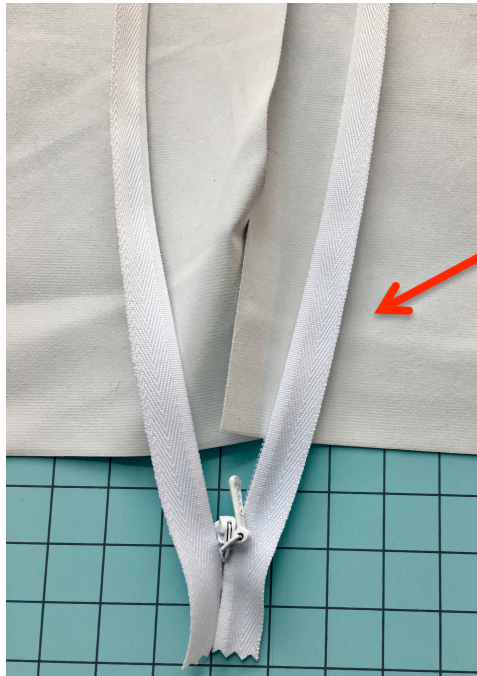
### Step 1

Lay out fabric with right side facing up as shown.

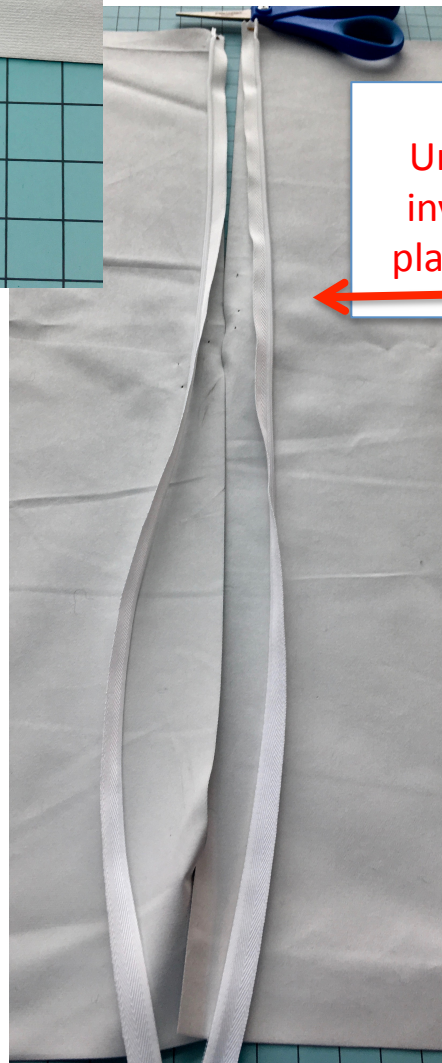
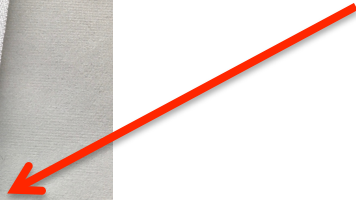


## Step 2

Line Zipper up – This is where I always get a little confused, so I will attempt to make it clear using these pictures.



Lay the Zipper facing up



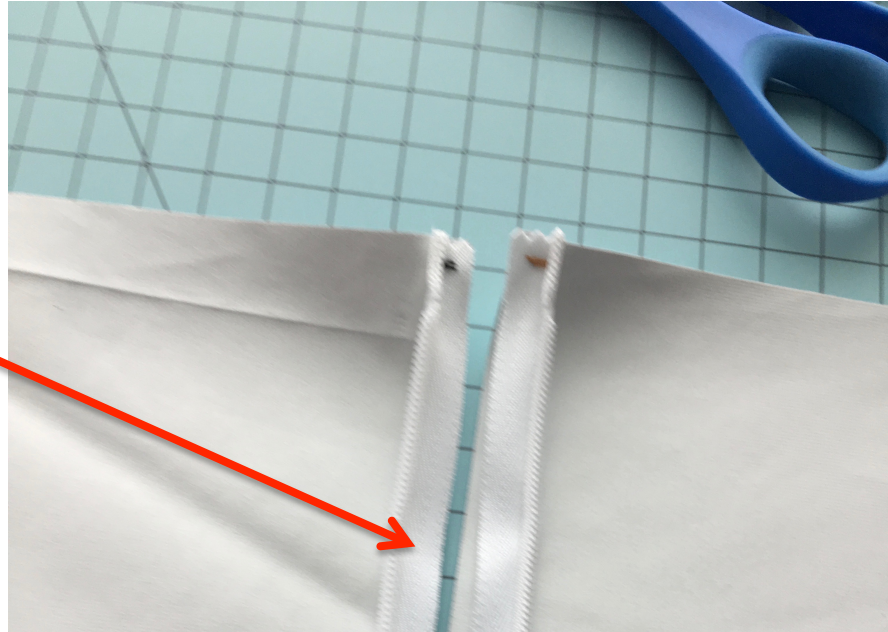
Unzip it and invert it into place and pin.



### Step 3

I always stitch the top piece in place to keep it from moving.

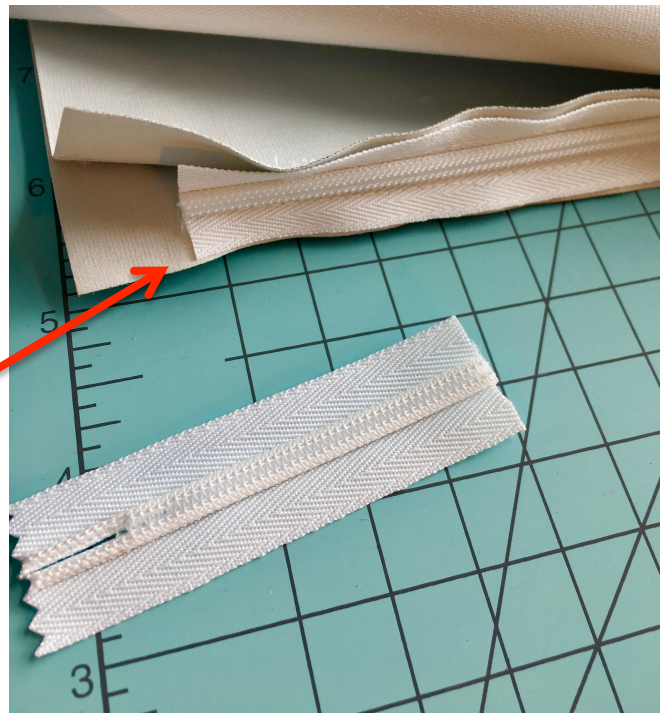
Place pins to hold zipper in place



### Step 4

Draw a line about an inch above the end of the fabric to stop sewing.

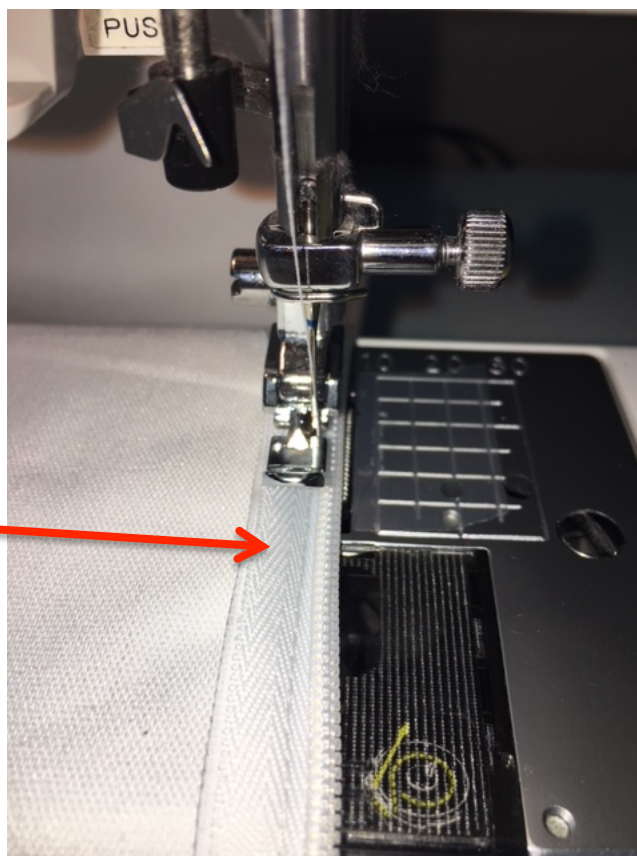
Note: This is what it will look like toward the end, this image is to show why you need to end the sewing here.



## Step 5

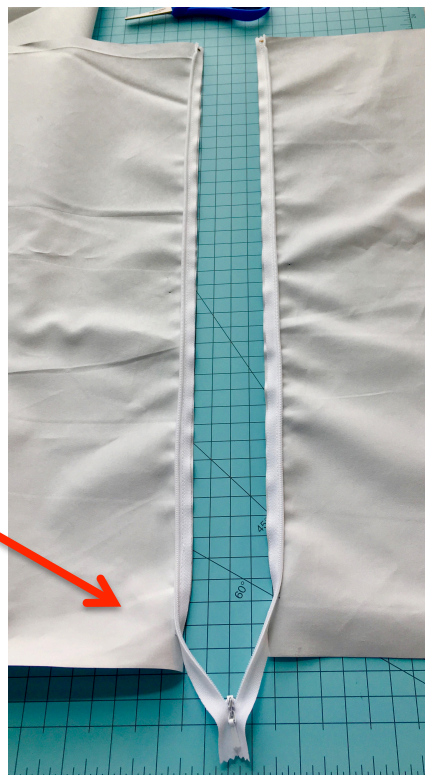
Using a zipper foot, line up the needle and stitch along the zipper.

Make sure not to sew the teeth



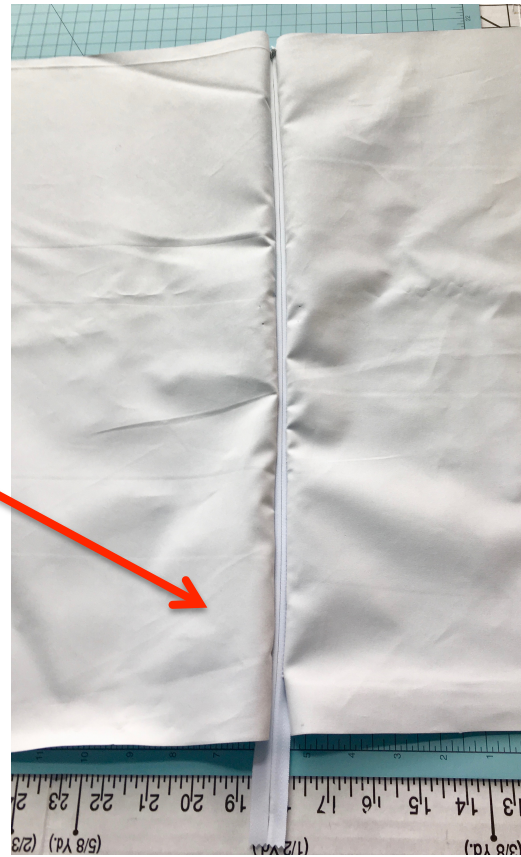
## Step 6

Once you have stitched the zipper in place it will look like this.



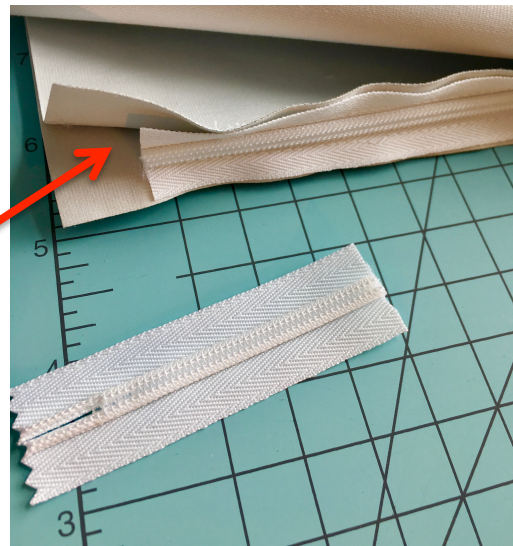
### Step 7

Zip the zipper and make sure it is working –  
Then unzip halfway.



### Step 8

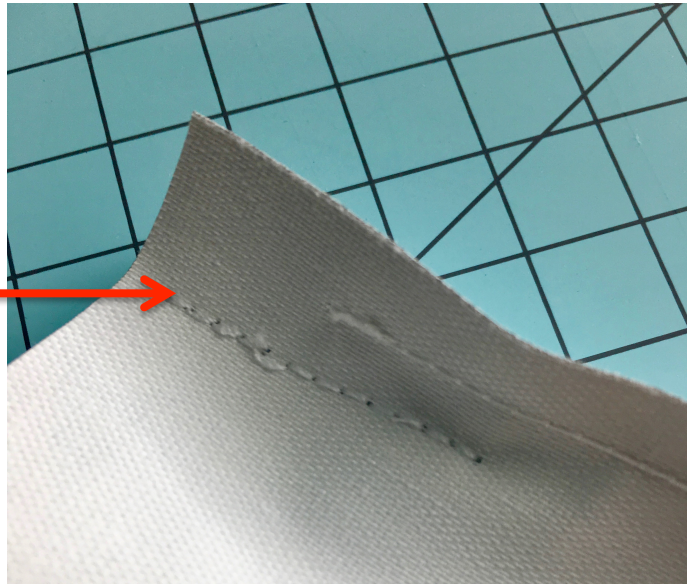
Cut the zipper where the stitching ended.



### Step 9

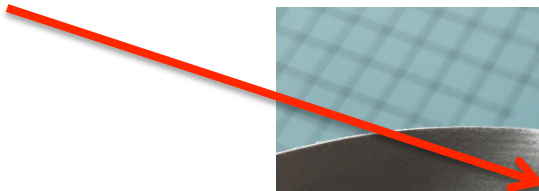
Fold over and stitch to the end of the fabric.

Finish stitching



### Step 10

Flip open and stitch the ends together to make a clean finish.

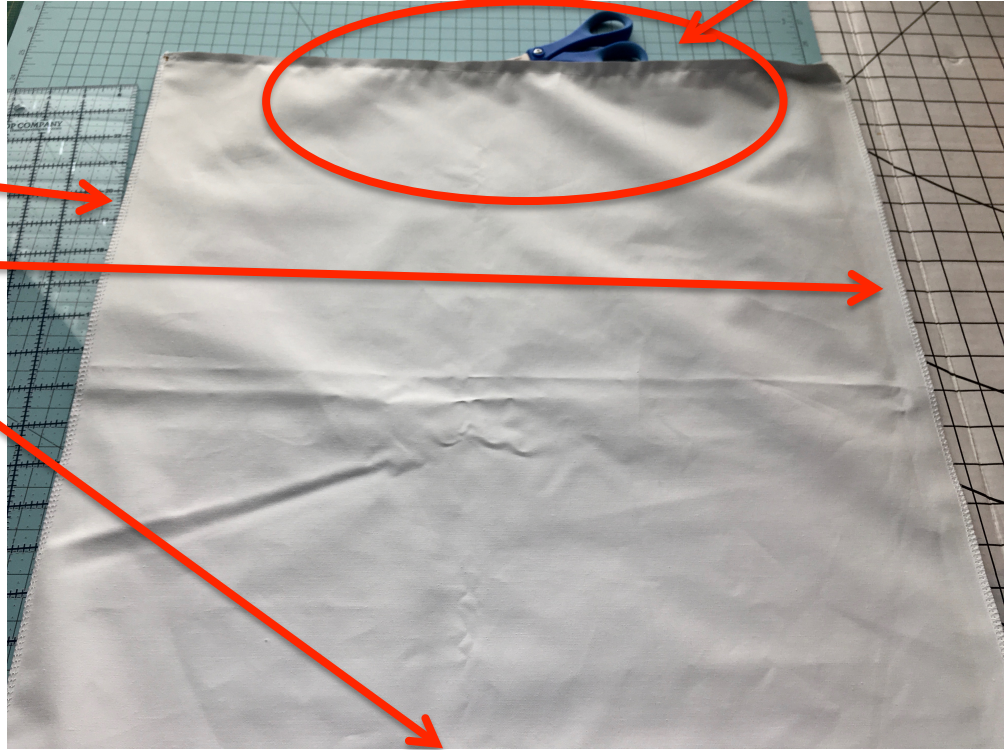


### Step 11

Fold inside out, with right sides together, and zipper halfway unzipped, and serge the three remaining sides of the pillow.

Keep Open – so you can flip it right side out!

Serge or Sew to finish edges



### Step 12

Turn right side out and insert pillow.



Place your pillow inside, and cover with a traditional pillow case, and you are finished! Enjoy! Sherri
