

Frank P. McDermott 1881-1925

Frank P. McDermott, deputy in the district's courts clerk office, for the past sixteen years, died at his home, 538 W. Seventh Street, Tuesday evening, Sept. 29, at 12 o'clock.

He was apparently in good health and worked all day Tuesday, but complained of being ill latter, and died suddenly.

Mr. McDermott was born in Dubuque July 19, 1881, and was the son of Mr. and Mrs. Peter McDermott, old residents of Dubuque. He was a Catholic and a member of St. Raphael's parish and was affiliated with the Eagles and Modern Woodsmen of America.

He is survived by his wife and two sons, Robert and Howard, and one daughter, Ione, a brother, E. C. McDermott, and one sister, Mrs. Howard Abbott, all of Dubuque. Funeral services were held Friday morning from the residence to the Cathedral. Internment was made in Mt. Olivet Cemetery.
