1715 - Samuel Goffe was accused of being a bastard child born of Elizabeth Sabin of Rehoboth. Anthony was bondsman for Samuel to appear in court to answer the charge. - what was the outcome?

1727 - Samuel Goffe was appoint guardian of James and Hezekiah Goffe (his brothers) after his father died.

Anthony was a deacon of Barrington and died in 1727 - what church?

James and Hezekiah dropped the "e" and changed the name to Goff.

Anthony may have been born in England. Need to confirm with Phillip Goff.
